I have to clarify the rules of check-in for my flight in advance on the website of the airline which services I am using





I am getting out of the carriage at the final stop of the train to Boryspil airport






I am going along the platform to the exit to the airport terminal

I am focusing on the navigation signs on the fence to my left and yellow tactile tiles - they are showing me where to go






I am coming to the terminal entrance

I am going in






I am showing my air ticket to the officer



I am on the first floor of the Terminal


I am going up to the third floor by escalator or lift







I am on the third floor of the Terminal






My flight number, its departure time and check-in desk are shown on the information board



There are 2 more information boards for the right side and for the left side







There is information desk below the board

I can ask questions here to clarify information






There are numbers of check-in counters above them

I am following the information signs

I am finding my check-in counter number and I am coming to it





The queue is standing along stretch barrier taps

I am not going over the barrier






I am waiting in a queue here





If I feel unwell, I will ask an airport employee for help





When it is my turn, I am at the check-in counter

I say hello or use alternative communication cards if possible






I am giving my passport to the airline representative



If I have luggage, I put it on a special belt, I can see its weight









The airline official is attaching a luggage tag to my suitcase





The luggage is moving along the belt

Later it will be loaded into the plane







They also add a tag to my hand luggage



I am given a boarding pass

I find the gate number, boarding and departure time







I receive a sticker with a barcode and information about my baggage

It is important to keep safe this sticker till the end of the journey





I am going to pass aviation security control

I can choose a passage for passengers with disabilities or passengers with children



I am showing my passport and boarding pass to the aviation security officer









They are checking for prohibited items here

I am putting my outerwear, hand luggage, electronic devices in containers

After screening, I will take them back






All electronic devices must be placed in separate containers


I will take them back after screening



If I am asked to take off my footwear, I will take it off and put on shoe covers













I am putting my footwear into the container





I am putting the containers on the belt





I am walking through a metal detector

It may beep if I have metal objects





Aviation security staff can do the screening with a special device or I can be checked manually

This is a standard procedurel am calm





I am taking my belongings back

I am going to pass passport control





There may be a queue

I am waiting calmly

The queue can be very long

If I feel unwell, I will tell the airport staff about it

If I can, I wait for my turn





I am giving my passport to the passport control officer

The passport control officer can look at my face closely

I am calm





I have to look into the camera when asked

This is a standard procedure





When the passport control officer gives me my documents, I take them and leave the passport control area





I am entering the boarding gate area

I see gate numbers and displays with flight information





I can get all the information I need from the information boards

Information boards are on the walls and columns of the departure hall

I find my gate number and go there




Gates D12-D16 are on the floor below, I can go down by escalator or lift







Gates D1A-D1B-D1C are on the floor below, I can go down by escalator or lift





I can use the services of the business lounge - the service is paid







I can buy something in Duty free shops







I am going to board an aircraft

I am not coming to the door while it is closed

Boarding may be delayed

I am waiting calmly and do not worry






I am waiting calmly for the time to board the plane

There may be a queue



I am showing my passport and boarding pass to an official

He/she is passing me to board the plane











My boarding pass must be scanned



If my gate is on the first floor, an apron bus will take me to an airstair








If my gate is on the second floor, I am directed to an aircraft airstair through a passenger boarding bridge, either through an exit to an apron bus, or on foot to the aircraft - the route depends on the airline
